

WORKSHEET (ARTICULATION 1)

Directions: Please do these activities aloud with an adult monitoring your speech sounds. Use the provided list of articulation words or make up your own. Check off each activity as you complete it.

1. **Play Charades**

Think of a word that starts with your targeted speech sound. Act it out and have other family members guess what it is. Then switch rolls and have them act out words while you guess.

2. **Use a flashlight**

Write, draw, or cut out pictures of your words and have a family member tape them around the room. Then turn off the light and try to find them with a flashlight. When you find each word, say it five times.

3. **Be the teacher**

Teach everyone in your family how to say your sound. Then have them practice saying the words like you.

4. **Playdough**

Make your sound in playdough (for example, make a letter "S" if you are working on that sound). Poke your finger in the letter 20 times and say the sound each time.

5. **Egg hunt**

Write, draw, or cut out pictures of words that have your speech sound. Put them in plastic eggs. Have a family member hide them around your home. Every time you find an egg, say the word five times.

6. **Story reading**

Have an adult read you a story. Whenever a word with your sound is read, repeat it three times with good articulation.
